



SERV OBN – Hospital Familiarisation Kettering General Hospital (KGH)





Routes Included:	John Radcliffe Hospital to Kettering General Hospital (JR – KGH)
Special Instructions:	Enter hospital using the Emergency Vehicle route, Park in the bay opposite the Out-patient & A&E entrance



To get to Kettering General Hospital (KGH) follow the sat nav route (in Trip Planner) from John Radcliffe (JR) to KGH

- This will lead you out onto the A40 and up to Wolvercote Roundabout.
- Turn right onto the A44 to the Pear Tree Roundabout
- Turn right onto the A34 to the Wendlebury Interchange
- Take the first exit onto the M40 North for one junction to exit 10
- Take the ramp off then turn right onto the B430 towards Cherwell Valley Services
- Cross over the M40
- Turn left onto the A43 to Northampton, Brackley, Milton Keynes and Silverstone
- Continue on the A43 until you reach the M1
- Take M1 South for one junction to exit 15
- Turn left onto A45
- Continue on A45 to Nene Valley and on past the turn to Northampton General Hospital
- At the following exit take the A43 to Kettering and Mkt Harboro' (A508)
- Follow the A43 through a number of roundabouts until you get to the junction with the A14
- Turn left onto the A14.

We will pick up the street level view of this route as we approach the turn off the A43 on to the A14 Northbound



As you approach the A14 junction make to the inside lane in preparation to take the first exit which is marked to the Midlands.



At the roundabout take the first exit to the A14




The A14 is a busy road, even at night and frequent traffic jams occur, be careful as you exit off the ramp and bear in mind you are taking the first exit off the A14. It is not very far and easy to get caught in the outside lane making progress.



Remain in the inside lane, the next exit is only a short way up the A14 so you need to be ready to exit.



Bear left onto the exit 7 ramp



As you join the ramp make for the outside lane as you will be taking the 5th exit.



The roundabout is controlled by traffic lights. Go right round until you get to the last exit (5th) before the A14 going the other way



Note the Premier Inn to the left, the Brewers fayre may still be there also. The exit is signed to the Hospital (see next slide)



Follow the signs to the Hospital, this is the A4300



Continue on to the next roundabout where you ignore the signs to the Hospital if you are driving a marked charity vehicle and continue straight on towards the Town Centre.

If you are not using a marked charity vehicle then turn right here and follow the hospital signs which bring you in via the Ambulance station. Skip to slide 18



At the roundabout continue on the A4300, while it is straight on it is actually the 3rd Exit



Take 3rd exit following sign to General Hospital



Continue straight on until you see the signs on left and right for the Emergency Vehicle Entrance. Turn right into Kettering General Hospital as we are allowed to follow this route into the hospital

Note: Go back to slide 14 if you are in a private car or on a private bike



Continue straight on be aware of traffic coming from the right.
If you are in a non-marked vehicle entering via the Ambulance Station route you will join here from the right when the Stop sign is circled.



At the roundabout take the first exit (left)




Again as an authorised vehicle you can ignore the no entry signs as you turn left.
Note: Private vehicles can also use this as it allows for Emergency Drop Offs. It is a good idea to display a BLOOD sign in your window if using a private vehicle



Follow the road round to the right noting the sign to Out-Patient & A&E.



Park in the bay on the right then enter the hospital through the door to Out-patients & A&E



After entering through Out-patient & A&E go straight and follow the corridor until you get to a sign for pathology, take the corridor to the right to point 20 on the map



To exit the hospital follow the one way system



At the roundabout go straight



Follow the Way Out sign around the outside of the car park



Just past the Ambulance Station turn right at the T junction which leads back to a roundabout where you can rejoin the A4300
